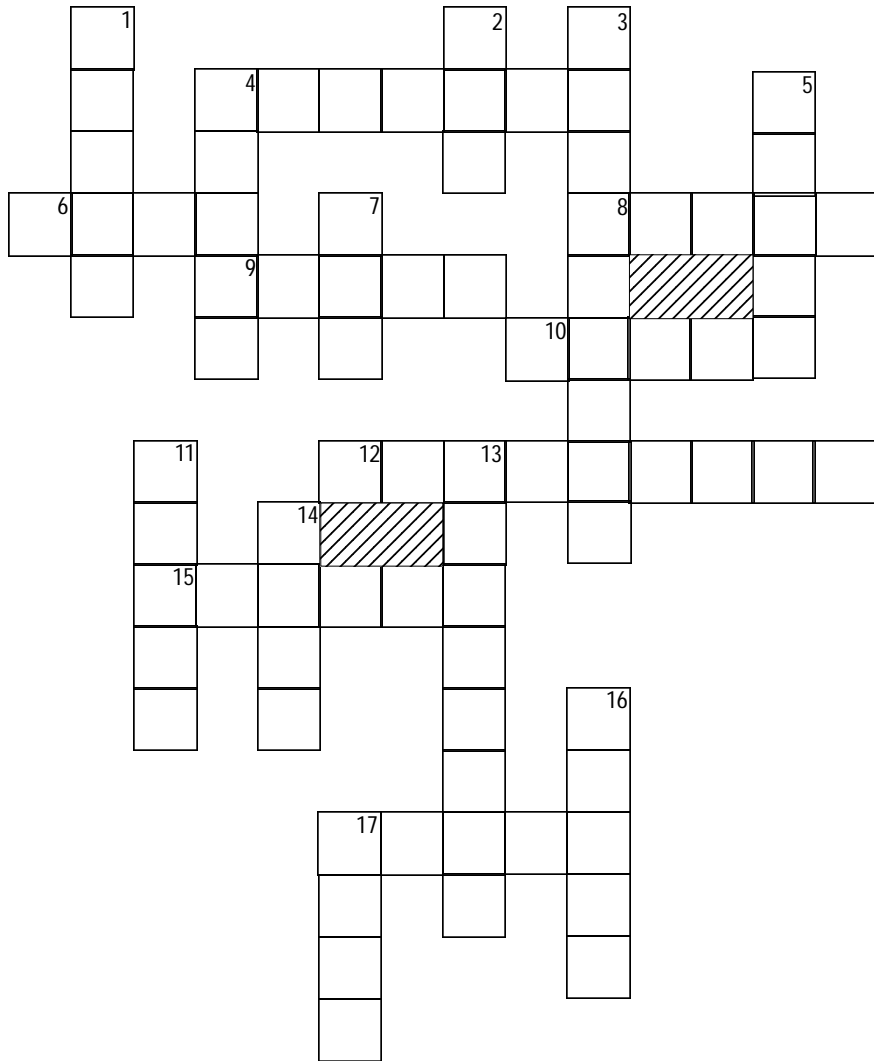


# Lansing 1897 Crossword Puzzle
